EARLY CHILDHOOD DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM

The Early Childhood Development Program provides services to children three to six years old who do not meet age appropriate developmental milestones and fall outside the scope of Department of Education, Special Education Services.

The needs of each child are met through the provision of professional therapeutic services for the child and support for those involved in the child's life in order to help them thrive in their home, community and preschool, and be better prepared for kindergarten and beyond.



INFANT CHILD DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM

Early intervention services for children birth to age three who have developmental concerns, as well as support and education for families.

Care coordination is available to help families utilize resources at home and in the community.

Support Plans are developed in partnership with the family and service team that build on strengths and priorities of the family.

Fact:
Research shows that early intervention greatly enhances children's development at a time when intervention is most effective.



NEWBORN HEARING SCREENING

- Hearing screening is provided for all newborns prior to discharge from Maui Memorial Medical Center.
- Early identification and intervention for all newborns with hearing loss.
- Outpatient testing is available for home births and infants missed at the hospital.
- Retesting and audiologic follow-up evaluations are recommended as needed.
- Referrals for early intervention are provided when appropriate.

Fact:
The average age of identification for hearing loss has been reduced from three years old to six months



Services are family centered, build on family resources and occur in the child's natural environment.

At Imua Family Services, evaluations and services are provided by a specialized team of :

- Care Coordinators
- Speech-Language Pathologists
- Occupational Therapists
- Physical Therapists
- Special Education Teachers



CAMP IMUA

- A week-long overnight recreational camp for school-age children with special needs.
- Every Child is supported by an individualized care team.
- All recreational activities are adapted for the special needs of our campers.
- Trained medical professionals are on site.
- Nutritional meals are provided by our chef!
- The annual summer time camp offers needed respite for families and caregivers.
